How will your money be used?

The Uniting Church Foundation has defined four core Mission Areas that are of equal significance to the Foundation. You can experience the joy of giving in your Will to provide continued support to make these Mission Areas possible in our communities.



1. Faith and Families

- training and leadership opportunities
- sports, cultural and recreational activities
- counselling services
- spiritual learning and support services
- child-care services (*with the exception of fee-based services*).



2. Indigenous Education

- fees for study/training
- assisting students with employment-related expenses such as trade equipment and travel
- providing study resources.



3. People in Crisis

- practical support for displaced individuals, households or communities
- crisis counselling services
- specialised ministry to enable community recovery.



4. Tomorrow's Church

- seed funding for fresh expressions of church
- funding church infrastructure in new and existing communities
- planting new Christian communities
- supporting environmental sustainability.
